Here we present you with some details you may find important.

- 1. Registration & Expenses. For the most part you can get the idea from the Registration Form above. The \$75 fee does not include meals or housing. Here are a few highlights.
 - → Discounts. Children under 12 are free. Youth and young adult dancers (12-25) are half price (\$37.50). The 1st-Timer special price is \$50. It is available by pre-registration only and for those who have never pre-registered for the Full Weekend before.
 - → *Individual sessions* may be paid for at the door. (Fri., Sat. morn, Sat. afternoon, Sun. morn., are \$13 each. Sun. afternoon \$8. Grand Dance \$20. Full Weekend \$80.)

- 2. Meals. Meals are an additional cost and are available only by preregistration. See the Registration Form above for costs.
 - ➤ Sorry, aside from a **basic vegetarian** option, we cannot accommodate special dietary needs.
 - → Registrations that include meals must be received by 12/31/08!

 Cancellations must be received before 1/02/09 in order to receive a refund for meal charges.
- 3. Lodging & Hospitality: You'll need to find a place to stay. The New England Center and Holiday Inn Express are in Durham.
